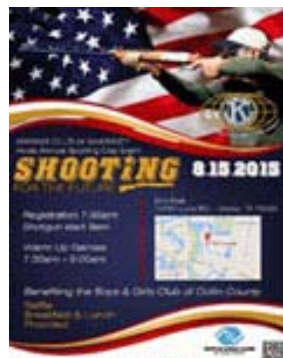
SHOOTING FOR THE FUTURE
