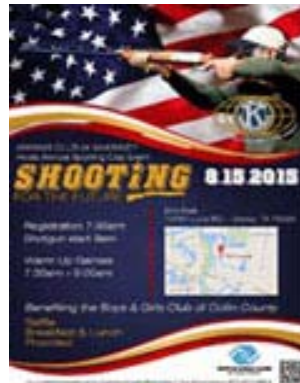


## SHOOTING FOR THE FUTURE
