**Candy corn** is a confection, popular in autumn around Halloween . It was created in the 1880s, made primarily from sugar, corn syrup, wax, artificial coloring and binders. A serving of Brach's Candy Corn is nineteen pieces, is 140 calories and has zero grams of fat. Originally the candy was made by hand. The final mixture was heated and poured into shaped molds. Three passes, one for each colored section, were required during the pouring process. The top is the wide yellow side and the orange is in the middle, white is the base even though it is the pointy side.
