### Kiwanis International Day at the White House

On Friday, September 21 two Texas Kiwanians were recognized as Champions of Change during the firstever Kiwanis International Day at the White House. Texas/Oklahoma was honored to have two Champions of Change. Our own Governor, Susan Hennum from the Kiwanis Club of Garland and Sanuana Zavala from the UT-Brownsville Circle K Int'l Club. Gov. Susan was honored for her global service. Since 2000, she has successfully partnered the two organizations she loves, Kiwanis and Buckner International Shoes for Orphan Souls, to collect hundreds of thousands of shoes for children in orphanages. She has raised many thousands of dollars to purchase even more shoes much of that generosity coming from her fellow Kiwanians. And Sanjuana Zavala from Brownsville was honored for her passion for the ELIMINATE Project. As a first-generation college student, Sanjuana Zavala holds back \$50 from every paycheck and \$200 from every scholarship- all to protect and save the lives of mothers and babies she will never meet. She teamed up her CKI club with the City of Brownsville's "Keep Beautiful" campaign and led a crayon-recycling effort. The project inspired Brownsville's elementary schools to donate used or unwanted crayons, which were then sorted, peeled, melted and molded into new crayons for children in need.
