

This Week in History:

In 1969, astronaut Neil Armstrong became the first man to walk on the moon. The next day, he and his partner, "Buzz" Aldrin, blasted off the surface of the moon to return home.

In 2010, British Petroleum stopped the flow of oil into the Gulf of Mexico after 85 days using a 75-ton cap lowered onto the well earlier in the week. Six Objects of Kiwanis International were approved by Kiwanis club delegates at the 1924 Convention in Denver, Colorado. They have remained unchanged.
