This week in History

1814, British forces invaded Washington, D.C., and set fire to the Capitol and the White House.

1882, the last legal hanging in Collin County.

1902, President Theodore Roosevelt became the first U.S. chief executive to ride in an automobile.

1905, the first sanctioned auto race in the county, began and ended at Old Settlers Park in conjunction with the annual picnic. The winning, average speed was 40 mph.

1910, a street car system began operations in McKinney.

1920, the 19th Amendment to the Constitution, which guarantees the right of women to vote.

1959. Hawaii became the 50th state of the union
