KIWANIS EDUCATION



The first president of Kiwanis International was George F. Hixson of the Rochester. New York. Kiwanis Club. He was elected in 1916 at the first international convention in Cleveland and reelected the next year. He is the only international president to serve two terms. The Hixson Fellowship of the Kiwanis International Foundation is named in his honor; Hixson medals are presented to donors who have contributed at least US\$1,000 to the Hixson Endowment Fund or the Global Campaign for Children (which includes funds raised for the IDD worldwide service project and The Eliminate Project.)

Our Club has given a Hixson medal to 18 of our members during our club campaign to Eliminate Iodine Deficiency Disorder (IDD). Did you know that a teaspoon of salt a year can get a person of mental, physical and birth defects including Thyroid enlargement – sometimes called "goiter"
