Club delegates approved in principle the establishment of Kiwanis districts at the Providence, Rhode Island, convention in 1918. The purpose of Kiwanis districts is to promote communication and interchange between clubs and to assist in the administrative responsibilities of Kiwanis International. Most of the original 29 districts were organized by the end of that year. In 2018 there are 49 districts with 8,072 adult clubs 8,427 youth clubs worldwide.
