The National Day of Prayer(5/3) was created in 1952 by a joint resolution of Congress \& signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. In 1988, the law was amended by both the House \& Senate signed into law by President Ronald Reagan Thursday, May 5, 1988, designating the first Thursday of May as a day of national prayer. Every president since 1952 has signed a National Day of Prayer proclamation. The Theme for 2018 is UNITY verse is Ephesians 4:3 "Making every effort to keep the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace".

Cinco de Mayo (the fifth of May) is celebrated to honor Mexico's victory over France at the Battle of Puebla during the Franco-Mexican War (1861-1867). Despite having a small band of fighters, the Mexicans were able to defeat the massive French army on May 5, 1862. Did you there is a misconception that Cinco de Mayo is a celebration of Mexico's Independence Day, but the fact is Mexicans celebrate their day of independence on September 16.
