The first president of **Kiwanis** International elected from outside the United States was the third, Henry J. Elliott of Montreal, Quebec, who served in 1919-20. As of 2011, seven other presidents have been Canadian. The first president elected from outside the two founding nations was Ian Perdriau AM, a member of the Kiwanis Club of Melbourne, Australia, who served in 1994-95. Eyjólfur "Eddie" Sigurðsson, a member of the Kiwanis Club of Reykjavik-Hekla, Iceland, served in 1995-96 as the first president elected from the European Federation.
